*In 1950 Angie came to the Embudo Presbyterian Hospital to work as an aide. At that time the hospital had many young women employed in various jobs. These girls attracted many young men and that is how Angie and Hector met. Angie and Lorraine Mascarenas, who married George Atencio, were best friends and met the two Atencio cousins while employed at the hospital. After they married they moved to Dixon, and lived behind Quirino and Corina's house near the plaza. Quirino and Corina were pillars of the Presbyterian Church, and ran the Dixon post office for many years. They also had a store, which sold very good clothing, equal to what was sold in Espanola. Angie and Hector's children attended the Mission School, and Jerry and Peter also attended Menaul School in Albuquerque. Jerry graduated from Menaul School in the mid 70's. Hector worked in Los Alamos, and Angie at the hospital in Embudo, and was an Avon representative for 25 years. She was active in the church, as an Elder, Deacon, and Trustee. Her involvement in women's association included working at the thrift store, in the Kitchen Kafe for the Dixon Arts and Craft Tour, potlucks, flea markets, etc. She also helped son Peter run Atencio's Store in Dixon, until it was closed. The children were involved in church school activities. Florencio was one of the young men who were instrumental in the stuccoing of the mission building. Florencio was well liked in the community and worked for people wherever he was needed. At his funeral, Rev. McComb said, "Florencio's job here on earth was completed and he was called to his heavenly home to be with his creator".*
